Rich enjoyed mentoring the younger engineers that worked for him in his department and the students at Old Dominion University (ODU). Rich served for 15 years as the Practitioner Advisor at ODU, providing guidance and mentorship to the next generation of engineers. After the events of May 31, the Outstanding Practitioner Award that the Committee on Student Members presents annually was renamed to honor him. Richard's dedication to ASCE and the students of Old Dominion University sets a standard of excellence for all practitioner advisors to strive for.
